

Key findings include a 13% increase in referrals over baseline data. FCFC actions as a result of this finding will remain the same. We will continue to work with our county partners to:

- **Ensure children and families are aware of and have access to necessary services.**
- **Refer children and families to the FAST Committee and service coordination as needed.**
- **Use the county-wide services check list as a base to determine what services families are in need of. Each agency/community partner will have access to this checklist so that they are aware of what services outside of their area may be available to the families they are working with.**

Key findings include an increase in the number of children being screened, but a decrease in the percentage of children connected to behavioral health services from the baseline year. FCF actions as a result of these finding will continue to remain the same.
