

We continue to build collaboration especially with the early childhood community. We have an active ECCC that encompasses issues pre-natally through age 6. We continue to have a 100% transition rate for HMGEI to Public Special Needs Pre-school. We are working with the 21st Century Learning Centers to provide parenting support with OCTF funding as well as in ABLE, Head Start and Early Head Start sites. The county is working more collaboratively through service coordination and working relations between SC Board of DD and Mental Health providers, Children Services are continuing to improve.
