

The KRA-L test has been replaced by the KRA test. However, data hasn't been released by the Ohio Department of Education on KRA scores as of this date. The KRA-L score listed for 2011-12 represents the most current data available for the indicator as it currently stands. Once KRA scores become available KRA scores will be reported and a new baseline established.

The 3rd grade and attendance indicators listed above are county-level composites; as such, they do not accurately reflect individual high-need districts. For example, the Band 1 KRA-L Score for Akron City Schools is 23%, as compared to Green Local Schools, which is 4.8%. As interventions, and/or strategies are developed to support School Success it is likely that more resources will be directed to high-need communities.

Fourteen of the 17 public school districts in Summit County participated in the YRBS. The survey was administered to all students in grades 7 through 12 among participating districts in 2012-2013. This data will be utilized to frame activities to support this indicator. There have been discussions regarding potential partnership with the Sandy Hook Promise as they promote school-based activities to support mental wellness.
