It is intended that high risk children and families will be identified and services—consistent across the board—provided to prevent the need for court involvement due to abuse, neglect, dependency, delinquent or unruly behavior</p>	<p>The Chair of the Wood County Service Coordination Team is the single point of contact for information about any referrals to the Wood County Service Coordination Team. Referrals may be made by any service provider or the family may self-refer.</p>	<p>A family making a self-referral will need to contact the Service Coordination Team Chairperson to schedule a meeting. The Chairperson is Sandi Carsey and can be reached at 419-373-6934</p>	<p>Families will be advised of their ability to identify and/or request a family advocate or other support person of their choice to participate in all meetings of the Wood County Service Coordination Team that are related to the child or family receiving services.
