


Coshocton County Family and Children First Council Shared Plan for SFYs 17-19

It has been a challenge to find the time to put together a survey and get it distributed to council for input and to collate the information into a usable format. The survey will be developed in June of 2017 and administered in July of 2017 with the findings to be presented at the August Council meeting. I have not had time to explore Red Tree House and assess how this resource might be useful in our county due to other more pressing priorities.

We have had very good attendance at the full council meetings. We have discussed 211 and how it is a benefit to our community and what funding support is available for the continuation of this resource for our county. Due to this discussion many agencies agreed to review their budgets to see if they could help with funding.

Our council is working well and we have an equal number of members and nonmembers who attend council meetings on a regular basis. We have been successful in bringing some partners who have not been at the table to the table this past year. Such as a School Superintendent from a school district that had not been represented in the past. We now have all 3 of our county schools represented on our council. The director of our local Drug and Alcohol Treatment Facility has also become reengaged and has resumed attending meetings after a several year absence from council. We also now have representation from the local sheriff's office the Juvenile Detective has been attending to represent the Sherriff's office.
