

Data collection is challenging in that we have to be careful not to duplicate any numbers when collecting data from various agencies in the County.

In FY2017, the Huron County MHAS Board promoted the Crisis Text Line heavily. Additionally, a number of council agencies distributed information about the Crisis Text Line to their clients. The number of youth receiving crisis interventions fell during the 2017 Fiscal Year by 25%.
