

Monroe Co. JFS reported that a total of 54 children were removed from homes. A total of 32 children were removed for neglect, 16 children were for parental drug abuse, and 4 children were removed for physical abuse and two for sexual abuse. Data does not reflect the amount of reports investigated but only children in out of placement.

**6. Identify any key findings (explanation of data findings; FCFC actions taken in response to key findings, etc.):**

There was a decrease in number of participants for the reporting period. Last year, there were 222 participants. This year the total was 129. A total of 53 students were not eligible for program due to income this is increase from previous year. Twenty -seven students achieved main goals. This is increase versus the ten last year. Forty eight students demonstrated improvement. There were 12 that decreased detention. This is increase from previous year. A total of 90 referrals were made to other agencies in order to assist families with obtaining needed services. This is an increase in referrals from previous year. A total of 228 school meetings were conducted with parents. A total of 36 reports were made to JFS of abuse/neglect. This is a decrease from last year.

A total of two students were suspended for drug usage (marijuana), zero for alcohol and one for tobacco (snuff).

A total of 13 Monroe Central High School Kiwanis key Club students participated in a KICK BUTTS DAY. Approximately 100 students signed the pledge not to use tobacco.
