


Van Wert County Family and Children First Council Shared Plan Update for SFYs 17-19

4. Identify any key findings (explanation of data findings; FCFC actions taken in response to key findings, etc.): The number of referrals connected to agencies serving clients 14-21 with transition into work or the workforce will be a measure collected yearly. A meeting was held in 2016 that included area school representatives and the providers of services that serve youth in transition into the workforce. The outcome of this meeting was that it would be beneficial toward serving clients to have additional meetings to share information on agencies, to improve communication between social workers and counselors and providers that serve youth in transition. FCFC of Van Wert County plans to facilitate the formation of a committee to make more effective and efficient the referral process of youth in transition to providers that can help them prepare and get connected to employment opportunities.
