

**3. List the data source(s) for the indicator(s):**

The Families and Schools Together pre and post-test reports are used. The most recent data is not yet available. The above data represents the statistically significant 0% increase. Each evaluation report represents the families in the program that school year. There was not a statistically significant increase for family cohesion; therefore, the data indicates 0. The committee determined that using 0% of parents reporting improvements would not be a valid representation from year to year. The composition of families in each program varies as does the level of functioning of the families at the beginning of the program.

Families are indicating improved social support and connection and also indicating improved family cohesion.
