

Red Treehouse established its roots in a partnership between Ohio Family and Children First (OFCF) and the Ronald McDonald House® of Cleveland, Inc (RMH).

OFCF, founded in 1993, is a partnership of state and local government, communities and families that enhances the well-being of Ohio's children and families by building community capacity, coordinating systems and services, and engaging and empowering families.

In 2004, the RMH collaborated with northeast Ohio organizations and families to establish Tools for Today and Tomorrow – a program to help families and professionals caring for children with chronic illnesses and/or disabilities access needed information, resources and support.

In 2011, OFCF's and RMH's efforts were combined as **Red Treehouse** in order to propel a broader, stronger resource for families, young adults and professionals statewide.
