

What services were most frequently used to address an identified need? What proportion of needs are serviced by a specific service or support?




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Developmental Disabilities Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Child Abuse Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Child Neglect Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Mental Health Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Alcohol/Drug Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Unruly Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Delinquent(cy) Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Physical Health Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Special Education Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Poverty Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified HMG Early Intervention Needs



Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Autism Spectrum Disorder Needs




Frequency of Services Utilized for Identified Primary Care Physician Need






Proportion of Needs Serviced by Utilizing Non-Clinical, In-Home Parent/Child Coaching




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Utilizing Non-Clinical Parent Support Groups




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Utilizing Parent Education




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Mentoring




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Respite Care (Including Camp)




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Transportation




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Social/Recreational Supports




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Safety and Adaptive Equipment




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Structured Activities to Support Family Functioning




Proportion of Needs Serviced by Parent Advocacy
